DIOCESAN PRAYER FOR THE WEEK: Lord, make me an instrument of your peace, where there is hatred, let me sow love, where there is injury, pardon, where there is discord, union, where there is doubt, faith, where there is despair, hope, where there is darkness, light, and where there is sadness, joy. Grant that we may not so much seek to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, it is in pardoning that we are pardoned, and it is in dying that we are born to eternal life.

TODAY IN OUR PRAYERS: Dyspraxia Awareness Week begins today. This is a form of developmental coordination disorder that affects motor coordination in children and adults. It may cause a child to appear clumsy and to perform tasks less well than expected. It may also affect speech. Pray for a better understanding of this condition.. **In the wider Anglican Church**, pray for The Episcopal Church and for The Most Revd Michael Curry, Presiding Bishop. Pray for the church where it is persecuted or opposed, and for all who face discrimination because of their beliefs. **In our diocese**, pray for The Ledbury Deanery, for the Rural Dean (Revd Robert Ward) and Lay Co-Chair (Sheila Mullaney); pray for the Cider Churches following the retirement of incumbent Howard Mayell last month, and for a good appointment to be made there. Continue to pray for the emerging Group Ministry, replacing the former Ledbury Team Ministry.. **In the wider world**, pray for the people of the stricken island of Sulawesi in Indonesia, for all seeking to aid them, and for the Emergency Disasters Committee Appeal. Continue to pray for the peace of the world, for all places of fear and conflict: for the Middle East, especially for Syria and Iraq; for Afghanistan; and for every family where there is division: for all victims of famine and for communities damaged by natural disaster; all members of the armed forces and those who work for peace. **Among the sick**, we're asked to pray for Sheila Mullaney; Ashley and Natalie; Elspeth Barks; Margaret Adams, Tim Ross, and all who support and care for them. **Remember all who have died recently**, and pray for all who mourn.
